



GENERAL ENGLISH COURSES ADULTS

The General English Group Course for Adults aims to help you improve your English language skills effectively in everyday situations.

The course, with a provided course book helps with the development of:

- ✓ The four basic skills: speaking, listening, writing and reading
- ✓ Grammatical accuracy (according to your current level)
- ✓ A good range in vocabulary (according to your current level)
- ✓ More accurate pronunciation
- ✓ Social English skills and useful language
- ✓ Learning skills to encourage self-study

Linguatime assesses your initial level of English in two ways:

- ✓ Students are asked to take an online placement test two weeks prior to arrival. Instructions on how to complete the test will be provided on your booking confirmation.
- ✓ On the first day at school students will have a short interview with our academic team to confirm the level attained on the online placement test.

There are five General English levels starting from Elementary to Advanced. The time needed to progress from one level to another depends on the initial level of the student and learner's performance during the course. Assessment is ongoing and in-class progress tests are done at the end of every week. In addition, a Change of Level Test has to be taken before moving to a higher level.

All our classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboards (or smartboards) connected to the web, and wifi is available throughout the school. This helps our highly-trained, dedicated teachers to supplement the course book with a vast range of modern teaching materials to make lessons more interesting and relevant to the students.

As a long term student, you also have the opportunity to book a monthly tutorial with our Director of Studies. This counselling session is an opportunity to discuss your progress in English and set an action plan for future development.

General English Course (30)

This course includes a General English Group Course (20) in the mornings (as above) with additional afternoon lessons which mainly focus on conversation and communication skills.

General English Intensive Course

This course includes the General English Group Course (20) usually in the mornings (as above) with additional afternoon one-to-one lessons, which are tailor-made to the student's needs.

General English ONE-TO-ONE

One-to-one private lessons are ideal for students who do not wish to be part of a class or for those who need to target specific areas of the language.

General English ONE-TO-TWO

These lessons can be booked by two students having the same level and travelling together and wishing to have lessons together at the same time with a teacher.
